# DOKOS ISLAND

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Dokos (meaning "beam" in Greek) is a small islet in the Saronicos –Argolicos bay, situated between Hydra and the opposite coast of Ermioni at the Peloponnese, close enough to Spetses. The landscape of the island is rocky and mountainous, while the highest peak is 308m. The island has few water reserves and the land is infertile. About 50 permanent inhabitants live today in Dokos and they occupy mostly with agriculture and fishing. Organized tourism is not developed there, but the island is known among nature lovers, hikers and free campers.

# LEONIDIO

This elegant seaside village offers a plethora of emotions. The singular architecture of the mansions and the towers as well as the beautiful nature which is an amalgam of sea and mountain won't disappoint the visitor. The main part of the traditional settlement is in the root of red rock which exceeds 250 meters and seems to dominate the area. You will see here the beautiful houses with the whitewashed walls, the wooden doors and the windows painted with vivid colors.

Located on the easternmost side of the Peloponnese, on the Arcadia prefecture, Kyparissi has been a favourite destination for some of the world's most notable figures including U.S. Politicians and the British Royals.

Next to the waves, under the hot sun, the birth place of Giannis Ritsos seems to glow as the "ship of stone" travels back in time, where Venetians and Ottomans wandered its cobbled alleyways. Monemvasia or poetic Monemvazia, Malvouazi for the Franks, Malmzy for the English and Monovasia for the local people, this imperishable homeland of the poet is like a trip in the past and one of the most favorite destinations for lovers.

NEAPOLI

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On the southeastern shore of the Gulf of Laconia, 115 kilometers from the prefectural capital of Sparta, is the seaside town of Neapoli. It stretches along the bay at the foot of the furthest outreaches of Mt. Parnon that form the peninsula of Epidaurus Limira, culminating in Cape Maleas.

# ELAFONISOS ISLAND

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Elafonissos, just 300 m from Pounta in the shore of Peloponnesus, has a history of about 5,000 years, since it was inhabited from the Third and Second Millenium B.C., as evidenced by prehistoric findings. During the Peloponnesian War it was a battle field between the Athenians and the Spartans, as the former had fortified the isthmus that connected at that time the island with Pounta. From 1839 until 1850 belonged to the British, which considered it part of the Eptanisa. It is connected with Pounta or Neapolis, Lakonia through local ferry boat routes. It extends over 9000 sq. m and has a population of 750 inhabitants.

# AGIOS FOKAS

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Agios Fokas is a Settlement in Monemvassia in Laconia in the Peloponnese Region of Greece. Agios Fokas is also a Agios Fokas is at an altitude of 40 meters. Approximately 34 people live in Agios Fokas. # GERAKAS

Also in the wider region lies the church of Agios Georgios of Gerakas which dates back from the 19th century.

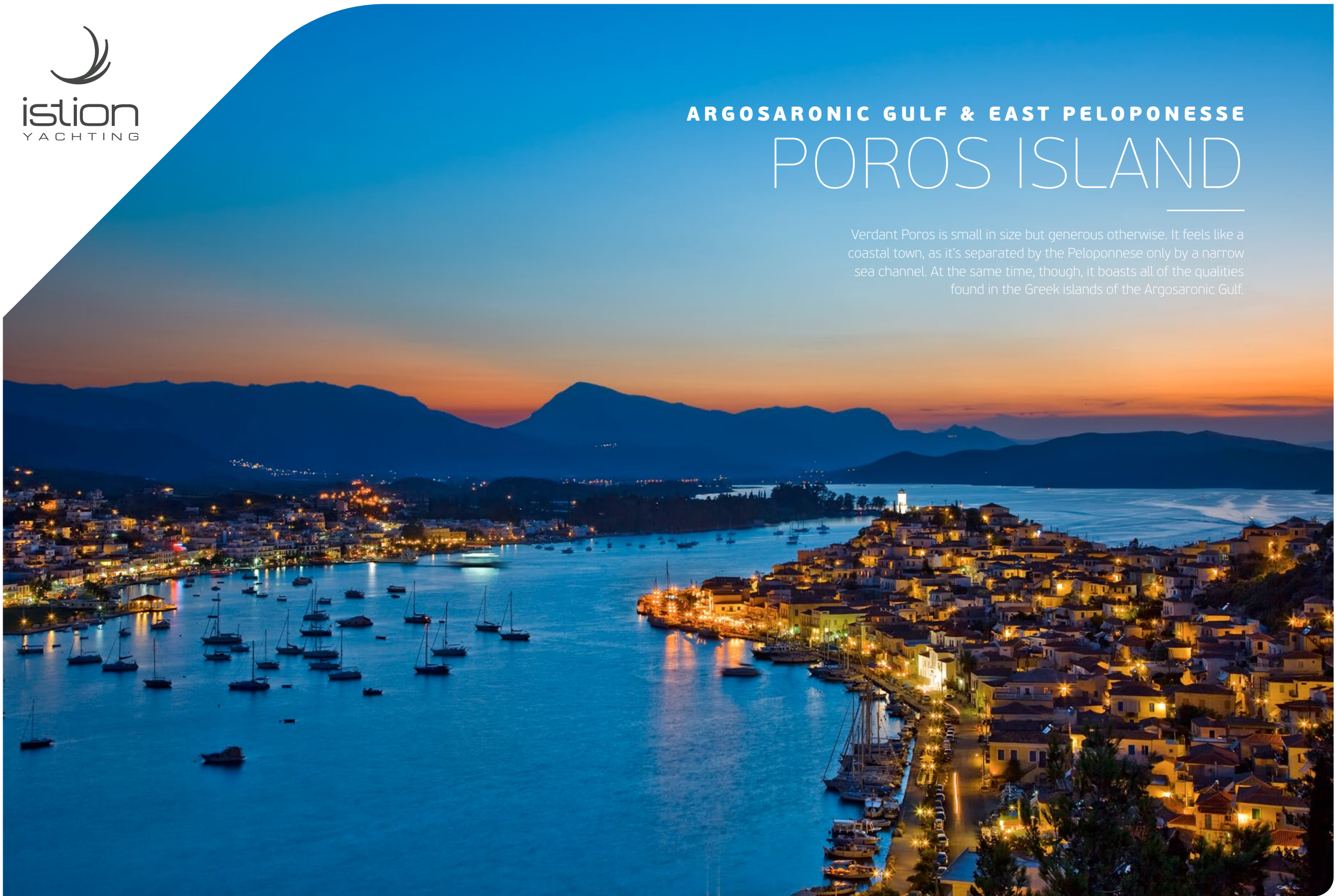

# EPIDAVROS

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Epidaurus is an area of mainland Greece which is found at the Peloponnese region.

The most important sight in Epidaurus Greece is the Ancient Theatre. Apart from the symmetry of this structure, the theater is unique because of its excellent state of conservation, which allows it to be still in working order. Another distinctive detail about this construction is the perfect acoustics. In fact, if you drop a pin on the stage, it will be heard even if your sitting at the last seats of the theater.
