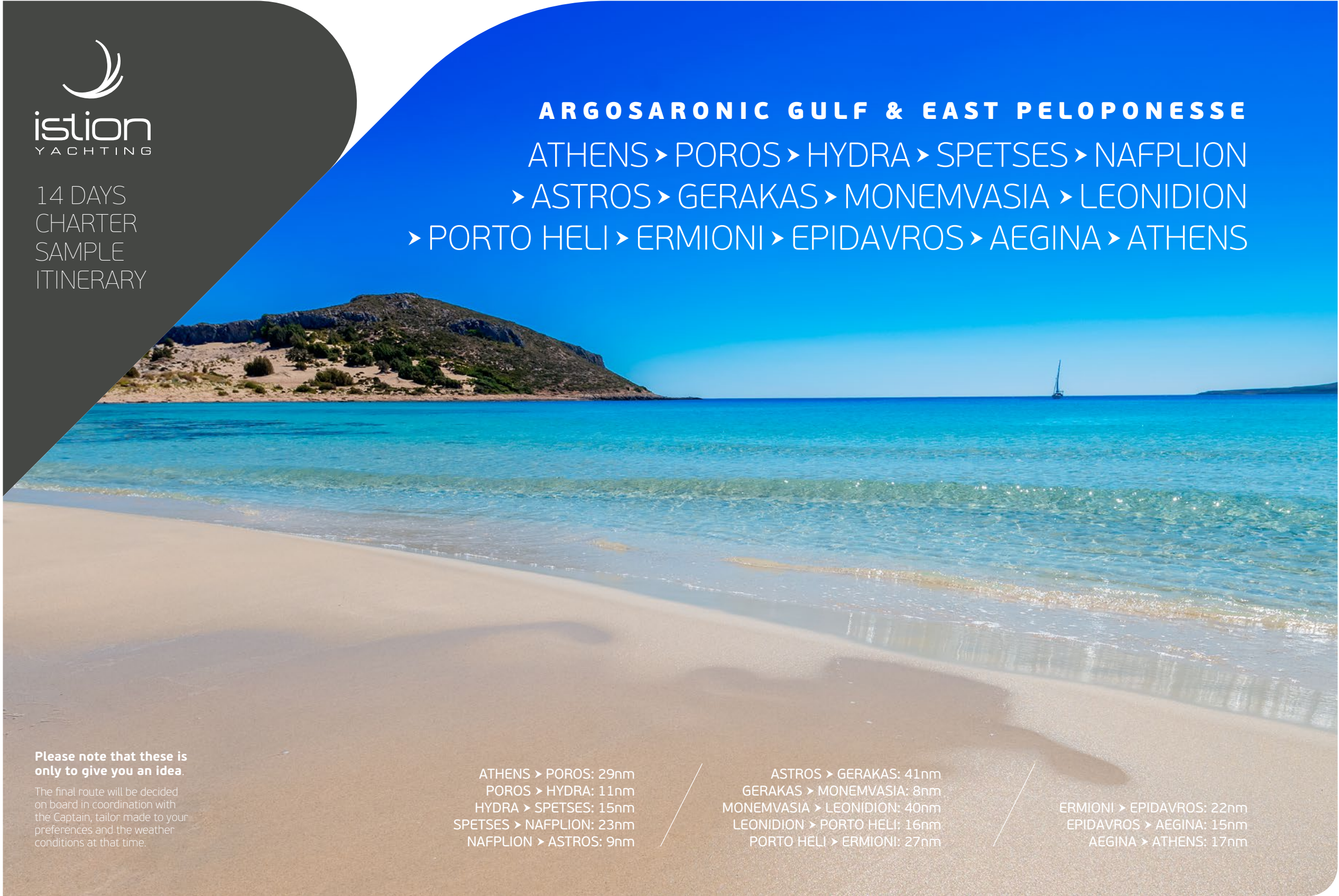

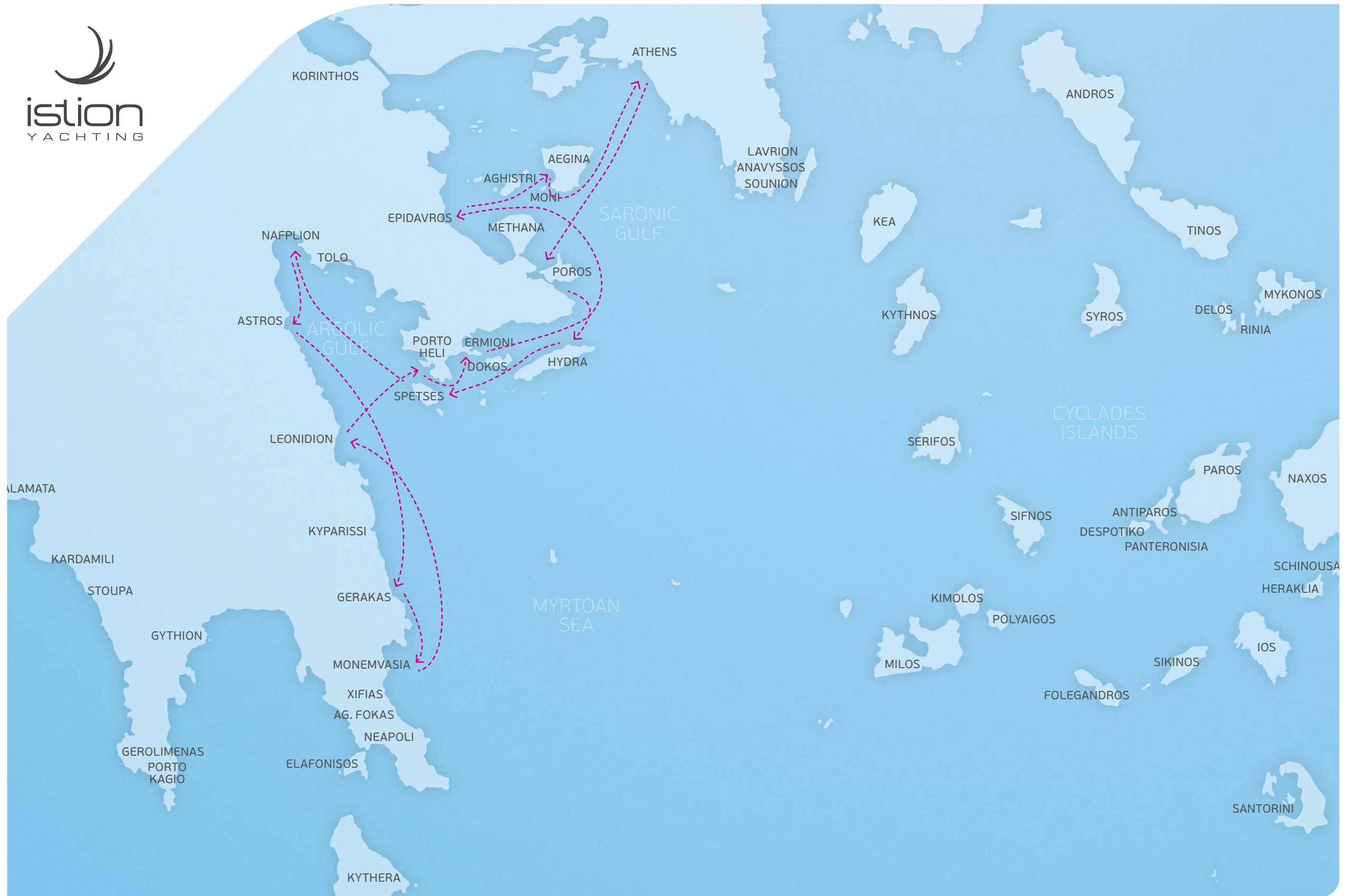

# POROS ISLAND

# HYDRA ISLAND

Hydra became famous all over the world in 1957 when the film "Boy on a Dolphin" was shot on the island with Sophia Loren leading the starring role; it is ever since that Hydra has been attracting the artistic, the wealthy and fashionable! A jet setter's haven, it has been home to Leonard Cohen and other celebrities; time has been spent here by John Lennon, Peter Ustinov, Melina Merkouri and many others as this island's jet set reputation is only second to that of Mykonos!

# SPETSES ISLAND

Its history, however, is much more exciting than that. Spetses is one of the Greek islands that played a major role to the Greek Revolution of 1821.

# ASTROS

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Paralio Astros is an authentic Greek village with nice atmosphere and hospitable locals. It resembles to an island and it has experienced significant tourist development in recent years. Its harbour reserves an safe boat shelter in the summer along with a nice beach with calm waters, ideal for families with children. There are numerous tavernas and bars and restaurants around the sandy bay. The charming Astros is an excellent base to stay and explore the surrounding area as it is close enough to Nafplion, Mycenae, Epidaurus and other interesting east argolic destinations.





## EAST PELOPONNESSE GERAKAS

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The village of Gerakas is surrounded by the impressive mountain of Parnon and has a picturesque port that attracts many of the visitors to Monemvasia. It lies 20 km north of Monemvasia town. It is known for its beautiful lagoon and the traditional fish taverns. Also in the wider region lies the church of Agios Georgios of Gerakas which dates back from the 19th century.

Monemvasia or poetic Monemvazia, Malvouazi for the Franks, Malmzy for the English and Monovasia for the local people, this imperishable homeland of the poet is like a trip in the past and one of the most favorite destinations for lovers.

## EAST PELOPONESSE LEONIDIO

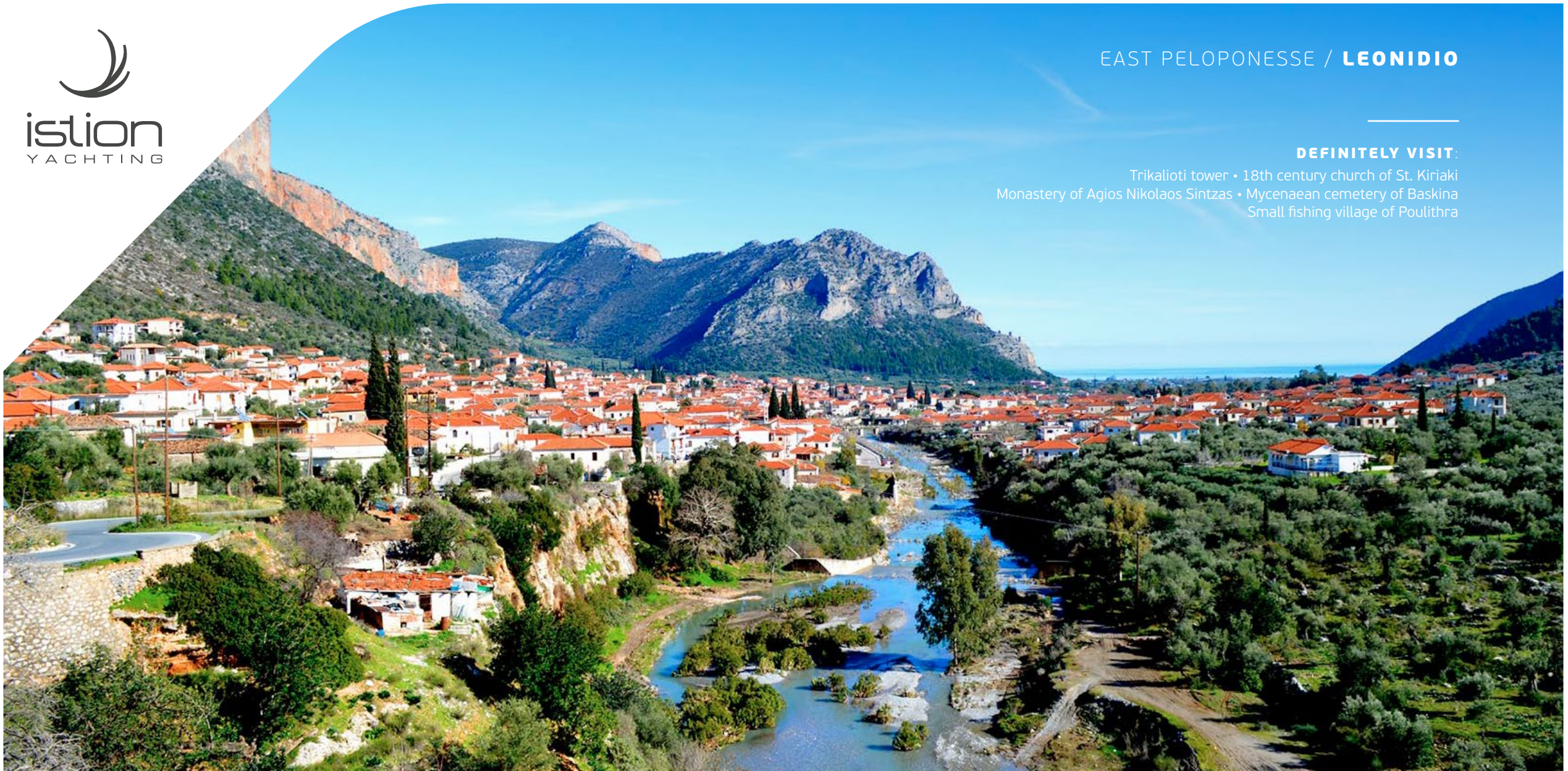
This elegant seaside village offers a plethora of emotions. The singular architecture of the mansions and the towers as well as the beautiful nature which is an amalgam of sea and mountain won't disappoint the visitor. The main part of the traditional settlement is in the root of red rock which exceeds 250 meters and seems to dominate the area. You will see here the beautiful houses with the whitewashed walls, the wooden doors and the windows painted with vivid colors.

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Epidaurus is an area of mainland Greece which is found at the Peloponnese region. The most important sight in Epidaurus Greece is the Ancient Theatre. Apart from the symmetry of this structure, the theater is unique because of its excellent state of conservation, which allows it to be still in working order. Another distinctive detail about this construction is the perfect acoustics. In fact, if you drop a pin on the stage, it will be heard even if your sitting at the last seats of the theater.
