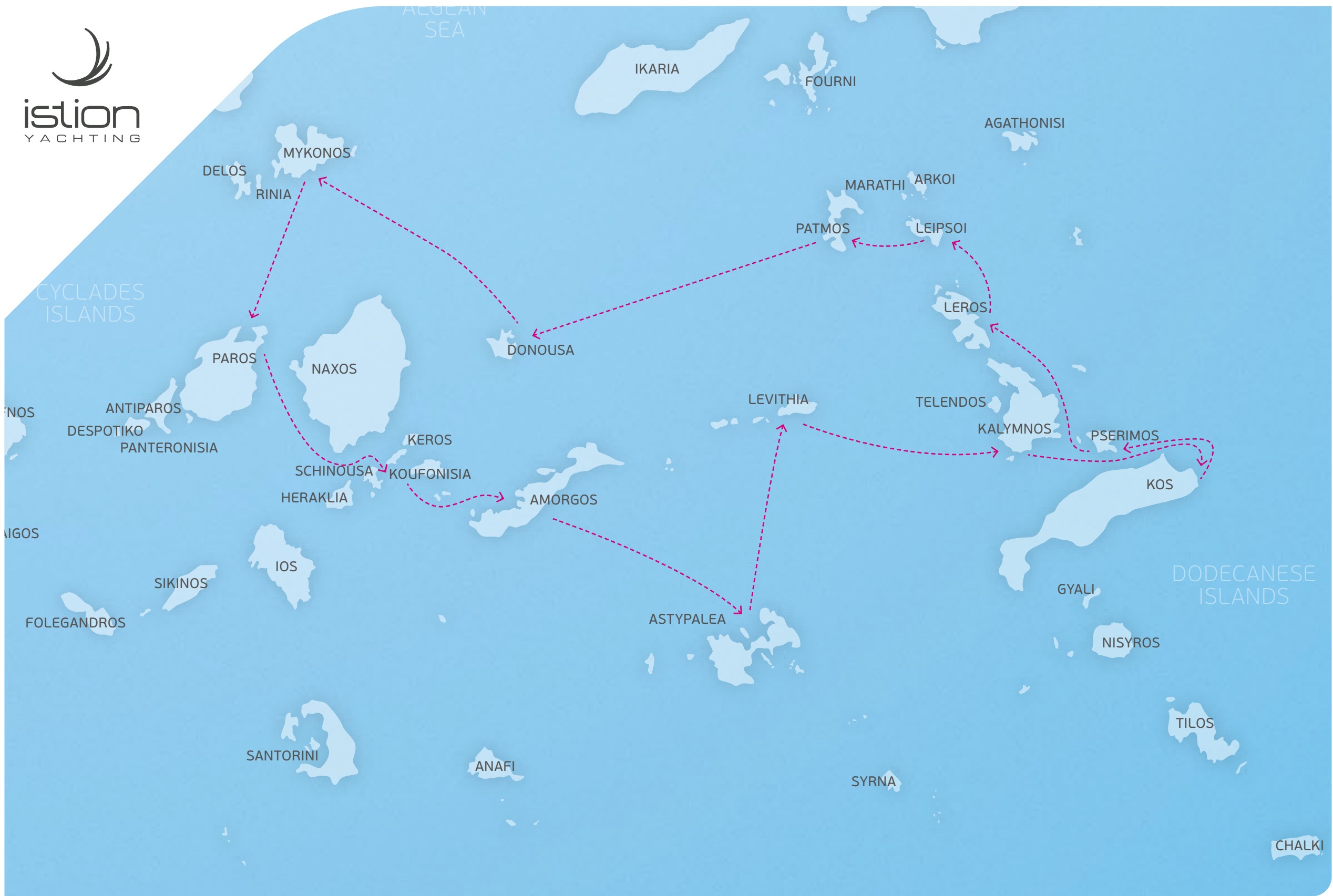

KOS ISLAND

PSERIMOS ISLAND

Pserimos has a 15 sq. km area and a population of approximately 150. This island offers the opportunity for a truly quiet vacation. Excavations have revealed ruins of an ancient settlement, certain archeologists consider it to have been the ancient dimos [town] of Perraiotan. Platy islet lies to the west a segment of it is a rocky isle known as Nekrothiki. All of Pserimos' beaches are good for swimming while the beach in Vathys cove is the best by far.



DODECANESE ISLANDS

LEROS ISLAND

According to mythology, this is the island of Artemis (Diana), the goddess of forests and hunting. It is ideal for peaceful vacation, while you will be amazed by its impressive architecture, clean coasts and the imposing castle of Panaghia, on Apitiki hill. The picture is completed with the hidden bays, hills, pine-trees forests, olive groves, and the law plain areas full of water springs.

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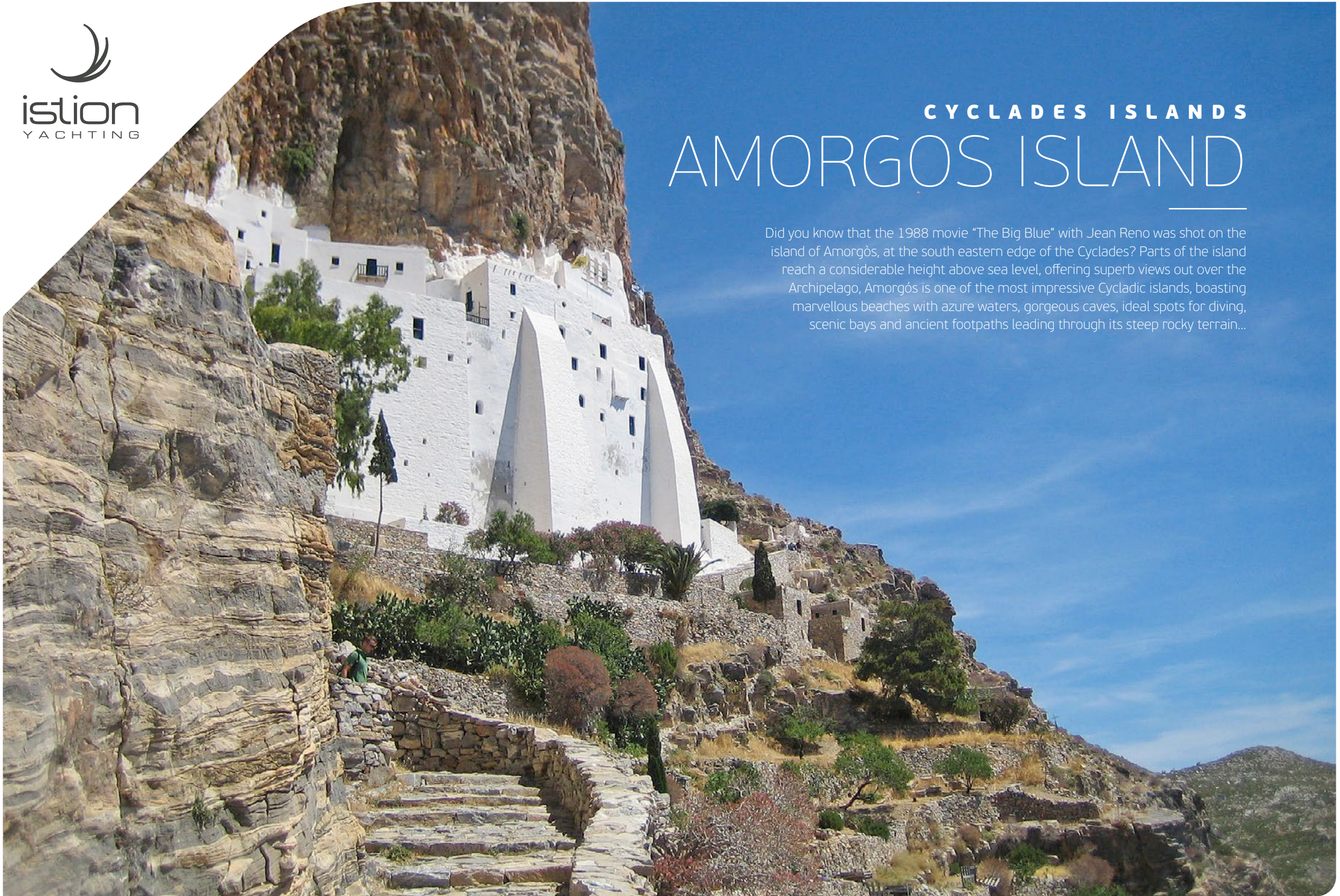

ASTYPALEA ISLAND

Astypalea in Greece is a little island in the Dodecanese island complex, in the southeastern Aegean Sea. Thanks to its secluded location, it has managed to emerge as a great alternative destination for relaxing holidays! Although it belongs to the Dodecanese islands, Astypalea has the characteristic Cycladic architecture. Cubic whitewashed houses and churches, narrow alleys, blue windows, and wooden balconies create a unique atmosphere that will blow you away. Chora, the island's capital, boasts a breathtaking view of the Aegean Sea. Agios Konstantinos, Pera Yalos and Livadi are among the best seashores.

LEVITHIA ISLAND

Between Amorgos and Kalymnos in the aegean sea lies the island of Levitha. This paradise corner of the Dodecanese is mainly known by sailors and there is only one family that lives there all the year round in total peace. It's coastline is very irregular in all points and these curves cause the formation of deep bays similar to small fiords. During the summer months Levitha is full of yachts and rented boats that use the island's deep water as shelter for the night. It is a very attracting place but a bit out of reach, ideal for resting between Patmos and Astypalea.



KALYMNOS ISLAND

Climbing up giant vertical rocks; diving in a sea bottom where centuries-old ship wrecks lie; enchanting caves; wonderful beaches and picturesque island settlements. This is Kalymnos: a destination offering more than you can imagine! Welcome to Kalymnos, the fourth largest island of the Dodecanese Group is widely known as an international sponge-harvesting trade center.
