CYCLADES MAKRONISOS ISLAND

The Island of Macronisos is located to the northwest of Kea island, opposite to Lavrio town. Its landscape is rocky and infertile and it presents ancient ruins of the Neolithic era. Its sad later history has eclipsed the island's significance in ancient times; It was the place of refuge for the beautiful Helen when the Trojan War broke out. Today Macronisos stands as an islet of torture and shame in the memory of the Greeks as it was turned into a prison for communists, political prisoner and defectors. Macronisos has been declared as a Civil War monument.



CYCLADES SYROS ISLAND

This is the island where Greek tradition and western influence come to a harmonious marriage.Ermoúpoli (meaning "the city of Hermes") is the island's capital town and has been the first important trade and industrial centre of the country in the 19th century. Evidence of this glorious past can be seen on public buildings (the City Hall, the Customs Office, "Apollo" theatre), on the neoclassical houses and at the beautiful squares.
